

## WLAQ ANNOUNCES CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

WLAQ is excited to announce a two tiered Corporate Membership option for organisations in Queensland.

In line with its 2015-2018 Strategic Plan and the work commenced under the 2015 Management Committee, WLAQ has been liaising with stakeholders in the profession regarding ways to expand its membership base and connect with wider profession.

From 1 July 2016, law firms and other organisations with less than 15 employed (or contracted) women lawyers will be eligible to apply for *Themis* membership at a cost of \$850 per year, and organisations with more than 16 employed (or contracted) women lawyers are eligible for *Justitia* membership at a cost of \$1,000 per year.

While not mandatory, it will be expected that corporate member organisations are signatories to Law Council of Australia's <u>Diversity and Equality Charter</u>.

President, Amelia Trotman thanks Vice-Presidents Cassandra Heilbronn and Ann-Maree David in their work for spearheading this initiative.
